Founded in 2012, Borgic Custom Pumping operates three draglines and pumps around 175 million gallons a year. Despite them "tearing the heck out of" Puck equipment, it lasts through the seasons.

Utilizing 8" Mainline hose from BullDog Hose with 6-7" drags to pump up to 3,000 gallons a minute, Borgic pumps swine, dairies, and does a lot of finishing barns. Borgic has also benefited from the technical side of Pump School, including the utilization of the LightSpeed control system to its full potential. Borgic hosted Puck's Pump School to share the key features on how to run a more profitable dragline operation.

Borgic reports that they've been taught by Puck's service team to rebuild a pump in order to save themselves money and increase efficiency.
